<b>Garganega-Pinot Grigio, Tanti Petali, Botter, 2017 (Veneto, Italy) £17.50</b> Light and leafy with a hint of pear and blossom. An easy going match for almost anything. 12%	£4.75	£6.25
<b>Sauvignon Blanc, Honores de Berticot, 2017 (IGP de l'Atlantique, France) £19.50</b> Grassy, dry Sauvignon from western France, with a pleasing, crisp, neat finish. 11.5%	£5.20	£7.00
<b>Chardonnay Reserva, Aves del Sur 2017 (Maule Valley, Chile) £21.00</b> Rich yellow in colour with an expressive nose, scents of bananas, white peaches and apricots mixed with notes of toffee, vanilla and dried fruits. It is soft, ample and generous with balanced natural acidity with a persistent finish. A great food wine. 13.5%	£5.50	£7.50
<b>Picpoul de Pinet M, 2017 (Languedoc, France ) £23.50</b> Fresh with a bright aroma of white flowers and zesty citrus. 13%	£6.00	£8.00
<b>Ermita de San Felices Rioja Blanco, Bodegas Santalba 2016 (Rioja, Spain) £24.50</b> A very fruity aroma with sweet overtones resulting from good quality Viura grapes. Well structured, good acidity and a long finish. This wine is highly recommended with seafood. 12.5%		
<b>Camel Valley Bacchus Dry, 2016 (Camel Valley, Cornwall, England) £27.50</b> Light, floral and delicate with apple blossom and a racy edge. A really vibrant, dry wine that shows the potential of our English vineyards. 13%		
<b>Sauvignon Blanc, Taworri, 2017 (Marlborough, New Zealand) £25.00</b> Benchmark New Zealand Sauvignon Blanc with all the classic notes this style of wine is famed for - crisp zesty character, gooseberry fruit, grassy notes and utterly delicious. 12.5%	£6.50	£8.75
<b>Mâcon-Lugny Les Genièvres, Louis Latour, 2016 (Burgundy, France) £29.50</b> Fresh with plenty of tropical fruit and a firm roundness. Ripe Chardonnay, with a touch of age. A good match for chicken or seafood stew. 13%		
<b>Pouilly Fumé, Guy Saget 2016/17 (Loire, France) £35.00</b> Classic Pouilly from the central vineyards of the Loire. Crisply refreshing aromatic fruit and an underlying suggestion of flint. 12.5%		

### Rosé Wine

<b>Pinot Grigio Rosato, Tanti Petali, Botter, 2017 (Italy) £17.50</b> Very light and refreshing with a delicate pear-drop fruit. Absolutely bright and fresh, terrifically easy to drink. 12%	£4.75	£6.25
<b>Urmeneta Cabernet Merlot Rose, 2016 (Central Valley, Chile) £18.50</b> Off-dry in style yet full of fresh, fruity strawberry and plum aromas. A refreshing palate makes for a moreish glass or two 12.5%	£5.00	£6.75

## Red Wine

<b>Merlot, Alta Baliza, 2017 (Central Valley, Chile) £17.50</b> An intense violet red colour. On the nose, aromas of mature fruits, red berries and some spiced notes. Rich in tannins with a medium body and has a mildly persistent finish. 13%	£4.75	£6.25
<b>Cabernet Sauvignon, Lion Ridge, 2016 (Western Cape, South Africa) £20.00</b> Juicy top-notes over the savoury flavours of a young, firm Cabernet. 14%		
<b>Primitivo-Negroamaro, Gran Rosso, 2016 (Salento, Italy) £20.00</b> Intense, full and complex with dark chocolate and black cherry character. A wonderful food wine with plenty of body and structure for hearty dishes. 13.5%	£5.25	£7.00
<b>Malbec, Avanti, Bodegas Borbore, 2017 (San Juan, Argentina) £21.00</b> Fully ripe, intense and glossy. It is bright and silky with vibrant hedgerow fruits and layers of subtle berry and spice flavours. 13%	£5.50	£7.50
<b>Ermita de San Felices Tinto, Santiago Ijalba, 2015 (Rioja, Spain) £24.50</b> Light and elegant with summer-pudding red berry fruit. Typical of good Tempranillo Rioja. 13.5%	£6.25	£8.50
<b>Shiraz De Bortoli Deen Vat 8, 2014 (South Eastern, Australia) £26.50</b> Ripe & generous dark for fruits creates this opulent textured style. The palate has supple vanilla tones with a backdrop of oak showing burnt chocolate. A balanced wine of soft tannins with lifted notes of pepper and spiced filling the mouth providing a smooth mellow generous finish. 14%		
<b>Fleurie, Chateau de L'abbaye 2015 (Beaujolais, Burgundy, France) £29.00</b> Beautifully floral as the name would suggest with notes of iris, violet, rose and peach. An elegant wine with smooth tanins, a classic from the Gamay grape. 12.5%		
<b>Pinot Noir, Hahn Winery, 2016 (California, USA) £32.50</b> This wine's bouquet charms with scents of red cherry, ripe strawberry, cola and spice. On the palate, soft mouthfeel complements flavours recalling plums and black cherry. Supple tannins and a dash of acidity end in a beautifully balanced, clean finish. 14.5%		

## Sparkling Wine & Champagne

<b>Prosecco, Borgo Sanleo, NV (Italy) £25.00</b> Intense floral, fruity bouquet. A wonderfully fresh and well-balanced, appley palate with just a hint of delicate almond. 11%		
<b>Camel Valley Brut, 2013/14 (Cornwall, England) £50.00</b> Superb local golden sparkler with elegant fizz and full, ripe flavour. 12.5%		
<b>Camel Valley Pinot Rose, 2015 (Cornwall, England) £55.00</b> A lovely floral and delicate strawberry fruit nose that drives into a brioche, fresh bread yeastiness supported by crisp acidity and a finish of great finesse. Excellent aperitif or with Cornish seafood. 12.5%		

## Dessert Wine

<b>Muscat de St Jean de Minervois, Domaine Les Tailhades, 2012/13 (South of France, France) £15.00</b> Expressive sweet wine, with dried apricot, exotic fruit, rose flower and orange peel aromas. Rich in the mouth with honey and citrus fruit notes on the finish. 15%	50ml	£2.50
